## Assessment of teaching by students

The online service for the evaluation of teaching by students is available for all courses in the bachelor's and master's degree courses.

The request is essential to proceed with the online booking of the exam relating to the course evaluated. The evaluations of the courses are in no way associated with the person who provided them

Non-attending students are also required to fill in an evaluation questionnaire, which is less complex than that proposed to attending students.

The questionnaire is organized in 5 sections:

- 1. Master or bachelor programme (questions D1—D3)
- 2. Course module (questions D4—D9)
- 3. Teaching (questions D10—D14)
- 4. Classrooms and equipment (questions D15—D6)
- 5. Satisfaction (questions D17—D18)

Here the text of the 18 questions.

ID	Question
D1	Is the overall workload of the courses officially scheduled in the reference period (two-month, three-month, semester, etc.) appropriate?
D2	Is the overall organization (timetable, exams, intermediate and final) of the courses officially scheduled in the reference period (two-month, three-month, semester, etc.) appropriate?
D3	Is the timetable of the lessons designed in such a way as to allow adequate individual study activity?
D4	Was the preliminary knowledge possessed sufficient for understanding the topics covered?
D5	Were the topics new or supplementary to the knowledge already acquired?
D6	Is the study load of this course proportionate to the credits assigned?
D7	Is the learning material (indicated or provided) adequate for the study of the subject?
D8	Are the supplementary didactic activities (exercises, workshops, seminars, etc.) useful for learning purposes?
D9	Have the methods of examination been clearly defined?
D10	Are the hours of the teaching activity respected?
D11	Does the teacher stimulate / motivate interest in the discipline?
D12	Please, judge the clarity of teacher's lectures
D13	Is the teaching staff actually available for clarifications and explanations?
D14	Is the teacher available and exhaustive on the occasion of requests for clarification?
D15	Are the classrooms in which the lessons take place adequate (can you see, hear, find a place)?

D16	Are the rooms and equipment for supplementary educational activities (exercises, laboratories, seminars, etc.) adequate?
D17	Are you interested in course's topics?
D18	Are you overall satisfied with the course?
